The i.MX RT1015 CM7 operates at up to 500 MHz with 128 KB on-chip RAM that can be configured as TCM or general-purpose. The family offers various memory interfaces and a wide range of connectivity interfaces including UART, SPI, I²C and USB. 100 LQFP packages for low-cost PCB designs.

The i.MX RT1015 family is supported by the [MCUXpresso ecosystem](#), which includes an SDK, a choice of IDEs and secure provisioning and configuration tools to enable rapid development.
